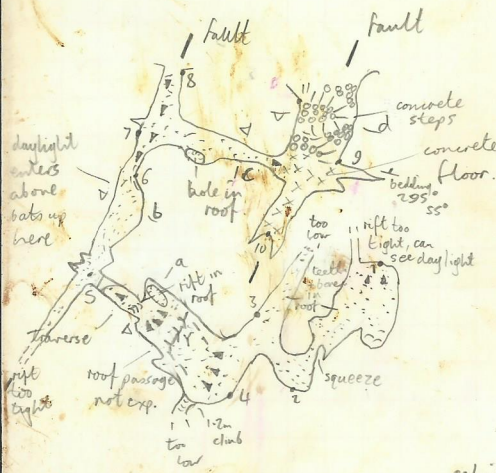
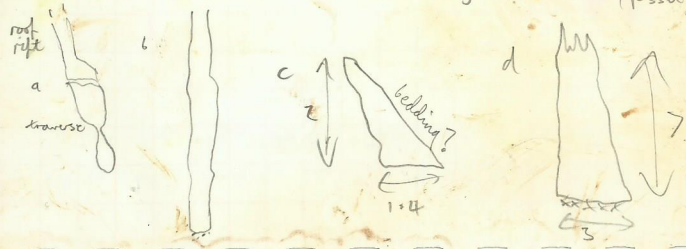

Cave has some high v. small bats in roof areas, pos. Kittie's also crickets, 2 sp. (small + v. large - 3cm long!) amblypygidae calcated sediments in roof and walls contain many bone fragments + teeth (fossil).
