
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
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
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Notes:

- 4 lots of survey data all the stations surveyed by Vern and me this year are prefixed by "k" with one exception (see below). Any station name that is just a numeral is one of the stations from the survey done by Keith and the others in 2016.
- Tham Maa 001 & 002 are inlets at the bottom of the cave originally noted but not explored in 2016 owing to lack of time. It's almost certain that the downstream sump in 001 is the upstream one in 002.
- The Tham Maa streamway data is just a line survey that we ran upstream from the only definite point we could find from 2016 in order to fix the position of the inlet, (Tham Maa 003).
- There is a station "a1" in the main streamway to get around the fact that I gave two successive stations the same number while underground only noticed when I started to crunch the numbers.
- Tham Maa 003 doesn't really start until about station k60 as there were several legs just to get across and up to the passage from the floor of the main drag.
- I have included some rough digital sketches as pdf files these are drawn up with and without the survey stations marked.
- Also included are the original survey notes and some screenshots of the data to help you with any drawing up.
