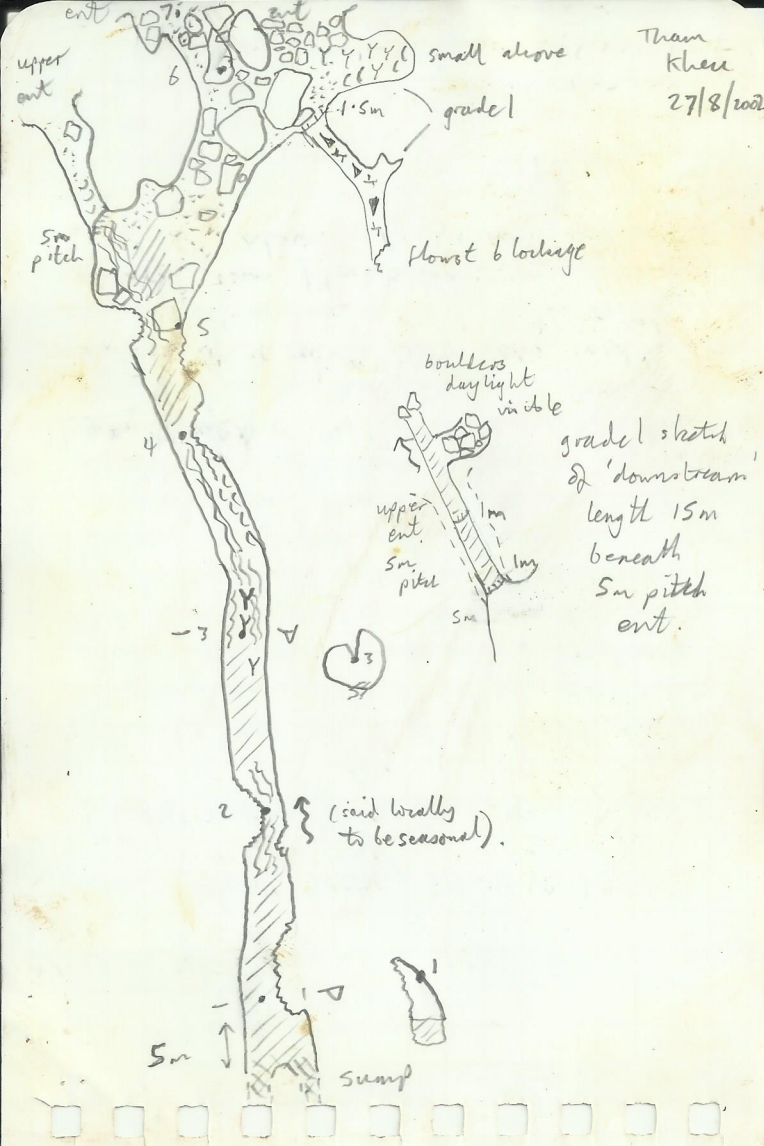

Exit at base of <sup>white</sup> cliff on north side  
of mountain. Find + follow seasonal  
stream to resurgence out of boulders  
Exit directly above leads to 5m  
pitch down to stream. To left and  
lower is second exit not requiring eqpt.  
Descent down boulders soon meets stream  
downstream - rift leads to boulders after 15m  
above rift is 5m pitch to upper exit.  
Upstream is walking in small passage  
c. 2m  $\phi$  to sump after 50m. In dry season  
sump dries out + cave continues to  
a large room (local info).  
Flow rate today c. 0.1 cumecs (estimated).

at sump at end of cave 1:35pm
