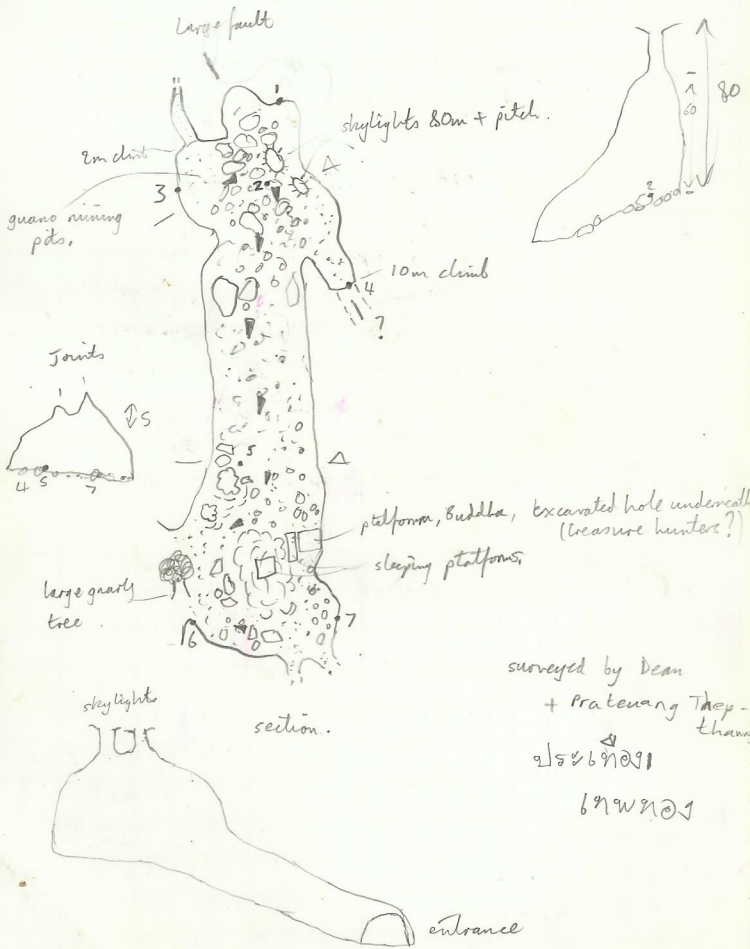

Cave is ancient phreatic tunnel leading to huge chamber with little breakdown + 2 skylight entrances 80m + high. Cave ascends steeply up dust + rubble slope, guano is minor, chamber is formed along large fault, passage on minor joint. Some evidence of guano mining in floor, old though. Buddha worship platforms are old + not used any more. No arch. material seen although there may be a good sequence of sed in floor. an ancient gnarly tamarind tree grows in entrance thought to be 100-150 yrs old.

Cave is not very interesting or pretty. Nil view overlooking Thung Kiao Sam Nai Yot though. Located on W. Side of K.S.P.Y. mountain. approached via dirt track + boat trip around side of Thung. c. 500m to South in ~~part~~ cliff is obvious entrance. ๕๗๗๗๗๗๗ Tham Wo.
