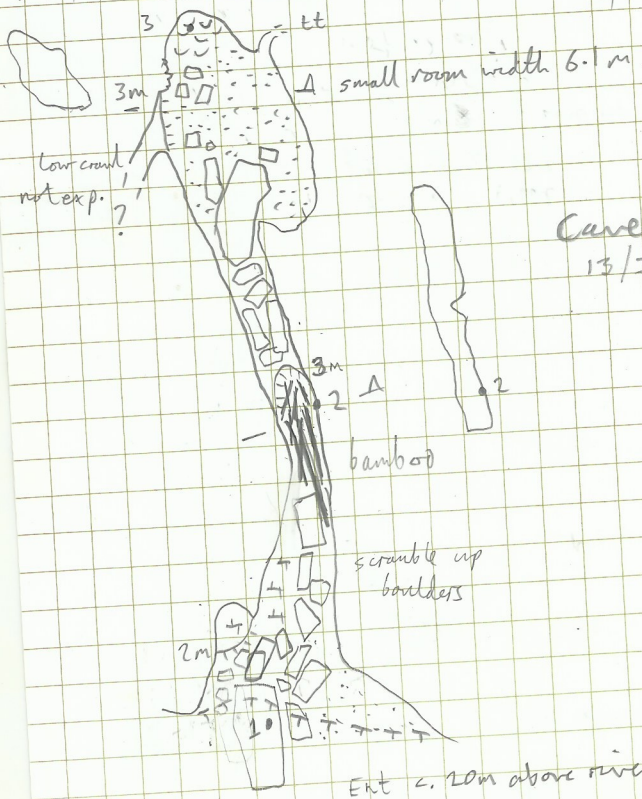

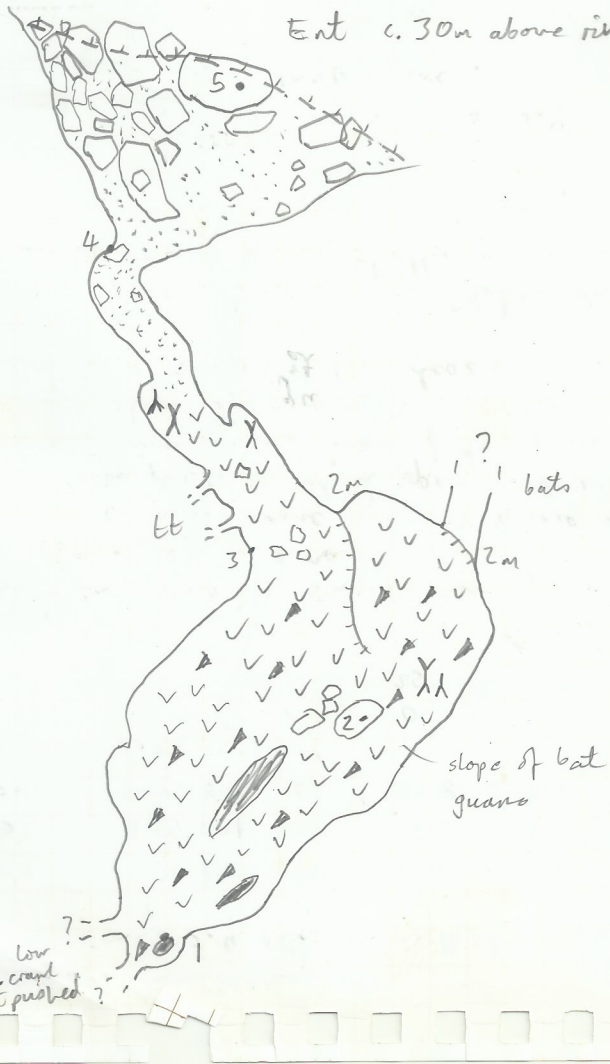

Bat cave located on SE bank, c. 100m upstream of cave no. 3. Very large entrance closes to a meandering phreatic passage which opens out into a medium sized room full of bats. Large slope of guano heads down to right + ends at low descending crandy.

Some pottery sheds, stone flakes and broken - end snails shells found in entrance. *vespertilionid*

Cave also appears to be used by ↑ porcupines. bat species not identified colony size 1000+ bats.
